And the most anticipated part is the red envelope, let's say, especially for the kids, the newest generation. But in the end, for most of us, the parents will take our red envelopes instead. They also have to give out and then we have to deposit back. And the day will last for let's say three days. And then after visiting the oldest member, the most senior member of the family, we will just go to other relatives in decreasing age order, I'll say. And we just spend time, especially for those we haven't seen for a long time. And it's really exciting but tiring days in the end
