Now it's the 30th, so people are starting to go in the cemetery to clean all the loved ones' homes there. Some people used to sleep over in the cemetery and gather there with all the families and then have some drinks and food brought with them to enjoy in the cemetery.

We normally cook dessert called sticky rice cooked in a bamboo. We have to cook it in a bamboo, like a roasted one. We put it all in the bamboo stick and then we fill it all with the sticky rice and filled with coconut milk and salt. I think that's the traditional All Souls celebration we used to.

We have to butcher a chicken for the dead ones and offer them during the night. In the altar, there must be a sticky rice, a chicken, a cooked chicken, and some favorite foods of the dead one in the altar. I think that's our usual ritual for All Souls' Day.
